**LADEN** on board the *Friendship Convict Ship 441 Tons And Armed* Master, by order of the *Commissioners for Victualling His Majesty's Navy* to be by him delivered to *His Excellency the Governor of New South Wales, for the use of Female Convicts, after their Arrival.*

The Master does engage to proceed immediately with the Provisions under-mentioned, Wind and Weather permitting, and to make the best of his way thither, and upon the delivery of the Stores, does also engage to take three Receipts from the Officers to whom the Cargo is consigned, or to whom it may be distributed; two of which Receipts are to be delivered by the Master to the Agent for Transports at the Port of delivery, or to be transmitted by himself agreeably to the printed Directions herewith delivered to him; and the other to be retained by the Master for the purpose of being delivered to his Employers: Understanding that in the event of his neglecting so to do, and the Ship be afterwards lost, an objection will be made to the payment of the Freight.

Delivered to him at the same time, a Set of Printed Instructions for his guidance, so far as respects the Victualling Department.
